Construction Update – Turbine Deliveries

Turbine deliveries for Kilgallioch Windfarm will begin soon and as someone living close to the delivery routes, we would like to give you advanced notice.

Located to the south of Barrhill, north east of New Luce and north west of Kirkcowan, when complete, the windfarm will have 96 turbines, capable of generating up to 239 megawatts of power.

On site works commenced in June 2015 and wind turbine deliveries are scheduled to begin in early February 2016. They are due to be complete by the end of 2016.

Gamesa has been appointed as our wind turbine supplier and they are working with us and Farrans Construction Ltd to erect the 96 wind turbines.

Turbine deliveries will be supported via a dual port approach between King George V Docks, Glasgow using the M74, A75 and then onto the local A714 and Cairnryan using the A77, A75 and then on to the A714.

Deliveries will take place outwith the peak hours of **0700 hrs to 0900 hrs** and **1600 hrs to 1730 hrs** to minimise disruption to local traffic flows.
