## 1 INTRODUCTION

1. This appendix provides an overview of the full range of methods used to publicise the Pre-Application Consultation (PAC) for the Project. It summarises how information about each consultation period was shared with stakeholders and the wider community, including direct email notifications, posters, postcards, social media activity, and newspaper advertisements. These measures ensured that the PAC was widely promoted across the host islands and that all interested parties had accessible opportunities to engage.

## 2 EMAIL TO STAKEHOLDERS

2. Emails were issued to key stakeholders to inform them of the PAC purpose and event details to encourage their participation in the consultation process.
3. Bespoke emails were sent to Community Councils, community organisations, environmental and heritage organisations, elected members, commercial fisheries organisations and individual fishers, and a wide range of other relevant stakeholders.

### 2.1 STATUTORY CONSULTATION ROUND ONE

4. Upon the launch of the first round of statutory consultation, stakeholders and communities were notified via email on 27 May 2025 about the launch of the six-week consultation, which was live from 26 May until Sunday 06 July. The emails contained links to the dedicated Public Consultation webpage on the Project website ([www.machairwind.com](http://www.machairwind.com)) which hosted the virtual consultation room, feedback form and supporting consultation materials (see **Appendix 8 Pre-Application Consultation Round One Materials**). A digital poster detailing the consultation purpose, events and timeframes was also attached, enabling stakeholders and communities to circulate the information to anyone that may have been interested in participating in the consultation. As important stakeholders to [MachairWind Offshore Windfarm](#), I am writing to notify you of MachairWind Limited's intention to submit a marine licence application under the Marine (Scotland) Act 2010 and our upcoming Pre-application Consultation (PAC). The below email summarises the proposed works and licensable marine activities and of our planned consultation. Full details of the events, and how you can share your views, will be issued to you in the coming weeks.

We are preparing a consent application for the Windfarm Development Area (WDA) infrastructure. Separate consent applications will be prepared for the Onshore and Offshore Transmission Development Areas at a later date, once a final grid connection location for the project has been confirmed by the Transmission Network Operator.

The consultation relates to all proposed infrastructure within the MachairWind WDA, with the key infrastructure being wind turbines on fixed foundations and inter-array cables which link the turbines together.

This year the project intends to hold two rounds of public consultation across Islay, Jura, Colonsay, Ross of Mull and Iona alongside online meetings and a virtual consultation room. Each round of consultation will take place over six weeks, involving both in person and online events.

This upcoming consultation, running from 26<sup>th</sup> May to 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2025 will provide stakeholders and communities the opportunity to:

- View and comment on visualisations of the WDA from local viewpoints;
- Find out more about the potential impacts and opportunities; and
- Talk to the project team and consultants about the windfarm development area proposals.

During the second round of consultation, due to take place in September/October, we will seek to demonstrate how feedback from the first PAC round has informed the decision-making process.

I will be in touch in the coming weeks to share more information on the upcoming PAC events, and the various ways that you can provide your feedback. I would be grateful if you could kindly support in sharing this information, when received, to your members and anyone else you think may be interested in the MachairWind project, so they have the opportunity to share their views on the project and comment on our windfarm development area proposals.

## 4 POSTCARDS

9. In advance of both Statutory Consultation periods, the Applicant delivered postcards via Royal Mail to homes and businesses on the islands of Islay, Jura, Colonsay, Ross of Mull and Iona. The postcards provided recipients with details of the consultation dates, event venues, project contact details, and ways to participate in the consultations.
10. This direct approach enabled the Project to reach address potential engagement barriers, such as expanding the outreach to those unable to leave their place of residence for health or other reasons. The postcards formed a core part of the Project's approach to inclusive engagement.

### 4.1 STATUTORY CONSULTATION ROUND ONE

11. Prior to launch of the first period of Statutory Consultation, from 07 May 2025, A5 postcards were posted to houses and businesses; in total, 3,450 postcards were delivered. The postcard is shown below (**Plate 4.1**).

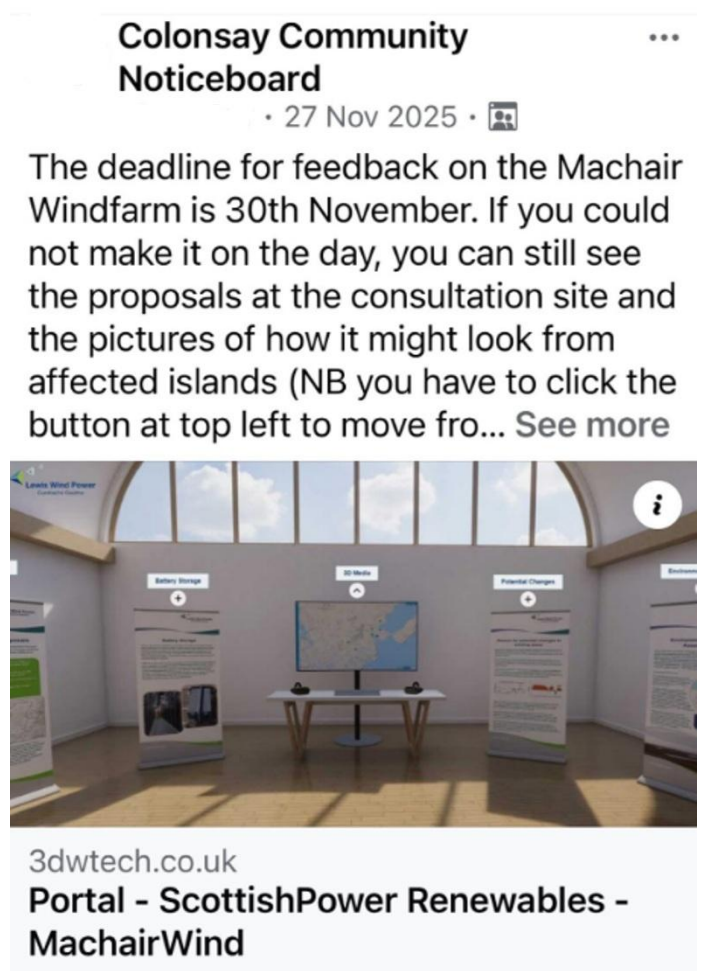
