### 1 Tourist Attractions Baseline Data

1. The five major tourist attractions in Ayrshire and Arran, based on VisitScotland's website, are listed in **Table 12.1**. The closest main tourist attraction is located approximately 15.4km north west of the Site Boundary at its closest point.
