**Further to the notice of an application for consent to construct and operate  
Douglas West Wind Farm Extension in South Lanarkshire,**

Notice is hereby given that Douglas West Extension Ltd. has been granted consent by Scottish Ministers under Section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 together with planning permission under section 57(2) of the Town & Country Planning Act (Scotland) 1997 to construct and operate Douglas West Wind Farm Extension, on the eastern part of Cumberhead Forest which lies to the north west of Douglas and south of Coalburn, South Lanarkshire (Central Grid Reference NS 80399 32105).

The installed capacity of the electricity generating station exceeds 50MW and comprises an 13 wind turbines with a maximum tip height of 200 metres and an energy storage facility.
