As directed by regulation 23(4) of the Electricity Works (Environmental Impact Assessment) (Scotland) Regulations 2017, notice is hereby given that **Hagshaw Hill Repowering Ltd** (“the Company”) has been granted **consent by Scottish Ministers to construct and operate a 14 turbine wind farm known as Hagshaw Hill Repowering wind farm, with a ground to blade tip height of up to 200 metres, and energy storage facility, in lands at Hagshaw Hill, near Douglas**, in the relevant Planning Authority area of South Lanarkshire Council.

Scottish Ministers have also directed, under Section 57 (2) of the Town & Country Planning Act (Scotland) 1997, that planning permission is deemed to be granted.
